Gävle, Sweden

Main responsibilities and expectations

- You will be part of a team with a good sense of community, strong team spirit and supportive colleagues.
- You will work in an organization that is at the forefront of development as we are up to date with the latest medicine.
- There are good development opportunities, including the possibility of internal and external training to further develop your profession.
- You will be a physician responsible for a 15-bed ward once every six weeks, daytime and evening on-call duties.
- Supervision of the residents of the clinic will be part of your duties.
- A placement in a radiotherapy unit will be based on competence and special interest.

What's expected of you

- To have medical and Oncology specialist titles issued or recognized by the European Union.
- To have good knowledge and experience as a specialist doctor in Oncology
- To show interest in teamwork and be willing to contribute to the clinic's development.
- To be able to take independent responsibility for different MDKs.
- To be able to complete the intensive Swedish language course, which is part of the MediCarrera program.

Salary and Conditions

- Swedish studies from B2 - C1 are combined with working in Region Gävleborg 50%/50%, working in the morning and studying online in the afternoon Monday - Friday.
- On-call work is divided between daytime shifts 8-17 and evening shifts 17-21. There are 1-2 daytime/evening shifts every two weeks. There is also a weekend shift Saturday-Sunday once every 3 months between 08.00-21.00.
- Salary is determined individually depending on specialist experience and qualifications.
- The average salary for a specialist doctors in Sweden is between 80.000 and 110.000 sek/month (7000-9600€) gross, duties paid separately. The salary is set individually according to specialist's years of experience.

ABOUT THE CLINIC



The Oncology Department at Gävle Hospital provides advanced medical treatment and care for cancer patients, primarily from Gästrikland, Hälsingland and northern Uppland. The department offers day care, outpatient care, inpatient care, radiotherapy and palliative care.

The department has around 150 employees, including 14 specialist physicians and 5 resident doctors, as well as nurses, contact nurses and assistant nurses. Patient care is organised through close interdisciplinary teamwork, with a strong focus on providing high-quality and individualised care.

Oncology is a continuously developing specialty, both in research and treatment options. The department follows new developments closely, including new medical treatments, and is also working on the continued development of tumour teams based on specialist competence.

The department offers a supportive and development-oriented working environment with strong team spirit and low staff turnover among specialist physicians. There are good opportunities for professional development, including both internal and external training to further strengthen clinical competence.
